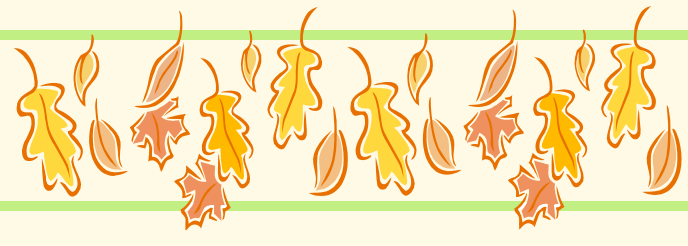

Being accredited means that Burton underwent a thorough review of its operation and provides assurance to families that Camp Burton has made a commitment to offering a safe, nurturing environment for children. ACA collaborates with the American Red Cross, the American Academy of Pediatrics and other youth service agencies in developing over 300 standards, from staff qualifications and training to emergency management, reflecting the most up-to-date research-based standards in camping operations. These standards exceed those necessary for state licensing. Burton passed with a score of 100%! Congratulations to Associate Minister for Camping and Student Ministries, Dave Scull, and his staff, for this important accomplishment!
